

ADMISSION TO GROUNDS: All Gate Entry Tickets are to be purchased via <u>www.trybooking.com/CMYZX</u>. <u>ALL TICKETS MUST BE SCANNED UPON ARRIVAL</u>

ENTRY FORM ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 1 WEEK PRIOR TO SHOW PRESENTATIONS WILL TAKE PLACE AT JUDGING RING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING JUDGING

- 1. All stock must be yarded at the Show Society Yards by 7.30 a.m. on **Sunday 3 March 2024**
- 2. Stock to be entered on a 'show only' basis. These stock remain the property of the bona fide owner.
- 3 All cattle must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for three (3) months prior to the Show.
- 4 All entries are received subject to the right of the stewards to reject any cattle not up to Show standard and if required, to arrange for same to be removed from the grounds before judging commences.
- 5 Stewards also retain the right to transfer any entry to a more suitable class.
- 6 All horned cattle to be well tipped (no longer than end of ear).
- 7 On arrival at the yards, all cattle must be penned by the owner or his representative.
- 8 Cattle cannot be entered for, or compete in, more than one class.
- 9 Grass fed, pasture fed or grain fed cattle are eligible for all classes, except Class 16 (grass fed)
- 10 For the convenience of exhibitors, the steward will inspect cattle during the week prior to the Show, if necessary.
- 11 In the event of the judge deciding that the exhibit in any class is not worthy of a prize, no prize will be given.
- 12 Single Champions can be selected from single classes only.
- 13 No cattle are allowed as non-competitive.
- 14 All cattle will be weighed prior to judging.
- 15 All exhibitors must remain outside the judging ring whilst the cattle are being judged.
- 16 Eligible cattle will compete for trophies regardless of owners or trophy donors.
- 17 Cattle without NLIS Tags will not be accepted
- 18 Cattle being exhibited are to be transported to and from the Show at Owners expense.

HEALTH REGULATIONS FOR BOTH STUD AND PRIME CATTLE

- 1. Stock MUST originate from herds free from Brucellosis, Tuberculosis and Trichomoniasis
- 2. Stock MUST be sprayed for ticks if they are from a tick area. Millmerran is in a tick free area.
- 3. Any animals coming across a state border must be accompanied by health papers signed by a Government Veterinarian in relation to their Johne's Disease status. Millmerran is in a Johne's protected area.
